## **How's your memory?**

Sometimes I think that we are so worried about our memory that we struggle to remember mostly because we are afraid that we can't remember: we've memorized all of our spelling words, history names, places, and dates...we've walked into a room and forgotten why we went in (honestly if that's one of the signs of Alzheimer's/dementia I've had it for about 25 years now), or one of my worst feelings is knowing someone's name until I'm right in front of that person or trying to recall the name in conversation. Performance anxiety is very much a part of our struggle to remember.

I've shared the story of my first day to volunteer at the Burton Bridge Ministry Client Choice Pantry (I really like that name) as a sermon illustration: I recognized someone who came into the Pantry but couldn't remember her name. So, I approached her and said, 'you look familiar.' Turns out we were in high school at the same time, not the same class. As she was leaving, she approached me and said "thank you for remembering me."

Remembering, even if we can't remember someone's name, is so significant. Significant enough that one of the thieves on the cross asked Jesus to remember him. We tend to focus on the response of Jesus-today you will be with me in paradise...paradise being the place Adam and Eve were before they learned of good and evil...but for the purpose of this little note, remembering is key. Bottom line is that Jesus responded 'yes, I will remember you.' Why is that so important?

Frederick Buechner writes, "(W)hen you remember me, it means that you have carried something of who I am with you, that I have left some mark of who I am on who you are." The Gospel of John is riddled with the language of unity. Most recently John 17:11 Jesus prays that God will protect us from the tempter that wants to divide us. Why? "...so that they may be one, as we are one." Elsewhere in John Jesus says that he is in the Father and the Father in him...he is in us and we are in him. In other words, he remembers us.

So, remember! If you see someone you haven't spoken to in a while, inside or outside the church, remember them: think about some experience, even if it's been years ago, and let them know that you carry something of who they are as a part of who you are. Do you remember when...? is a good way to begin. If reconciliation is truly a part of our confession and forgiveness routine, this is one way to practice that all-important part of what it means to be a follower of Jesus. It's a part of what I believe he means when he says "I'm going to prepare a place for you...so that where I am you may be also." It's the way, the truth, and the life of Jesus Christ. He promises to remember you! Go and do likewise!

In August, the Synod provided the following statistics which were included in the January 2023 annual congregational meeting report from the Call Committee:

In communications with the Synod, the Bishop's associate stated that many of those available for a call are near retirement or they are a part of a clergy couple who needs two calls near each other. Other candidates are choosing to interview elsewhere before considering a Texas call or a rural call.

When the call process started at the end of February 2021, there were nearly 2,000 candidates available for call. At the beginning of August 2022, the Synod database of pastors indicated that there were 420 pastors available for a call which equates to one pastor for every four open calls in the ELCA. With the pool of candidates being much smaller, the Synod has not had any candidates to offer Zion.

After recently reaching out to the Synod, we have not been presented further candidates for consideration.

We appreciate everyone's continued support, patience, and prayers during this time.
